

2023-24 Transfer Equivalents for Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) and A-Level Exams

Minimum Scores

ArtCenter awards Humanities & Sciences transfer credit for scores of:

• **AP exam:** 4 or 5

IB Higher Level exam*: 5, 6 or 7

• Advanced Level (A-Level) exam*: C and above

Units Awarded

Qualified AP and IB scores equal 3 units (one course) at ArtCenter. Qualified A-Level scores equal 6 units (2 courses) at ArtCenter.

Official Test Scores

Provisional credit may be awarded based on unofficial transcripts or exam results but will not be finalized until official results are received. Official reports must be sent directly from College Board, IB qualified institution, CIE, or other testing agency for credit to be awarded.

Art Exams Not Eligible for Credit

ArtCenter only awards credits for Humanities and Sciences and <u>does not award studio art transfer credit</u> for AP/IB/A-Level exams.

Deadline for Receiving Credit

All exams should be submitted by the week prior to Orientation, so adjustments can be made to your schedule if necessary. All transfer credit must be finalized by the end of the student's first term at ArtCenter. It is the student's responsibility to provide final official transcripts and test results.

Humanities & Sciences Credit Distribution

For the Bachelor of Fine Arts or Bachelor of Science degree, ArtCenter requires 42-45 units in Humanities and Sciences credits. Each major/program has a specific number and type of transfer credits that can be awarded. Transfer credits fall within four categories or "distribution requirements" as listed in the table below.
