Built: Six story office building was originally built in 1983.

Project Size: 6,300 Square Feet

Project Type: Renovation

Structure: Ground floor gallery space within ArtCenter's 1111 South Arroyo Parkway Building, one of the newest additions to their growing South Campus.

Function: State-of-the-art automotive gallery space with concrete floors, floor to ceiling glass facade. Exterior patio with built-in bench seating that flanks the featured 'fin wall'. The space features large sliding pocket doors that open up to allow cars to enter and exit. The space is designed to showcase automobiles and vehicles as art, highlighting ArtCenter's role in innovative transportation design. In addition to transportation related exhibits the multi-functional gallery is planned to showcase various topics in art and design in the coming years.

Features: Curvilinear feature wall keys into the aerodynamic shape of automobiles in an otherwise rectilinear space. The curved wall frames the entry into the gallery. The shape of the wall reflects the exact turning radius of a modern automobile. The wall extends outside de-materializing into a "fin wall" comprised of 12-foot tall steel elements. This public sculpture runs the length of the gallery's facade along South Arroyo Parkway creating a subtle screen. The wall features a lenticular effect. Approached from the South it reads "Mullin" while it reads "Gallery" from the North. DJA's design also includes some exterior hardscape to extend the gallery into the parking lot on the northside of the building.
